

Off-Campus Access

In order to access ÉTS library resources from off-campus, you will need to sign-in to the libraries proxy server. The method you use to sign-in will vary based upon the browser you are using.

Authentication

Once your browser is configured correctly, a pop-up window should appear when you try to access a library resource. Your identifiers are your **ETS email address** (@ens.etsmtl.ca) and your **ETS password**.

Windows 10 and 11

1. Click on the **Start** menu, and on the **Settings** icon.
2. Click on the **Network & Internet** icon.
3. In the menu on the left, click on **Proxy**.
4. Check only the box for **Use setup script**.
5. In the **Script address** field, type: <http://bibliotheque.etsmtl.ca/proxy.pac> and click on the **Save** button.

Firefox on Windows 10 - extra steps

1. Click on the burger menu > **Options** > **General**
2. In the **Network settings** section, click on the **Settings...** button.
3. Check the box **Use system proxy settings** and click the **OK** button.
4. In the Firefox address bar, type `about:config` and press the Enter key.
5. Click on the **I'll be careful, I promise!** button.
6. Type in the search box: `ntlm` and press the Enter key.
7. Double click on **network.automatic-ntlm-auth.allow-proxies**. It will change the value to **False**.

Firefox on Windows 11 - extra steps

1. Click on the burger menu > **Options** > **General**
2. In the **Network settings** section, click on the **Settings...** button.
3. Check the box **Use system proxy settings** and click the **OK** button.
4. In the Firefox address bar, type `about:config` and press the Enter key.
5. Click on the **I'll be careful, I promise!** button.
6. Type **network.negotiate-auth.allow-proxies** in the search bar.
7. Double click on **network.negotiate-auth.allow-proxies** to the value to **False**.

Other Windows versions

Internet Explorer

1. Click on the **Tools** menu > **Internet Options**.
2. In the **Connections** tab, click on the **LAN settings** button.
3. Check the option **Use automatic configuration script**.
4. In the **Address** field, type exactly: <http://bibliotheque.etsmtl.ca/proxy.pac> and click on the **OK** button.
5. Close and reopen Internet Explorer.

Microsoft Edge

1. Access the Options menu (using the three dots in the top right corner).
2. Select **Settings**.
3. At the bottom of the menu, click on **View advanced settings**.
4. Click on **Open proxy settings**. A window will open.
5. In the window, click on **Use a proxy server** option to turn it on.
6. In the **Address** field, type exactly: <http://bibliotheque.etsmtl.ca/proxy.pac> and click on the **Save** button.
7. Close and reopen Microsoft Edge.

Mozilla Firefox

1. Click on the burger **menu** > **Options**.
2. In the **Network settings** section, click on the **Settings...** button.
3. Check the box **Automatic proxy configuration URL**.
4. In the field under it, type exactly: <http://bibliotheque.etsmtl.ca/proxy.pac> and click on the **OK** button.
5. Close and reopen Firefox.

Google Chrome

1. Access the menu using the three dots in the top right corner.
2. Click on **Settings**.
3. At the bottom of the page, click **Advanced**.
4. In the **System** section, click on **Open proxy settings**. A window will open.
5. In the **Connections** tab, click on the **LAN settings** button.
6. Check the option **Use automatic configuration script**.
7. In the **Address** field, type exactly: <http://bibliotheque.etsmtl.ca/proxy.pac> and click on the **OK** button.
8. Close and reopen Chrome.

Safari or Chrome on a Mac OS

1. Click on the Apple menu (top left), and click on **System Preferences**. A window will open.
2. Click on **Network**.
3. In the left section, select **Wi-Fi** and click on the **Advanced** button (lower right corner).
4. Click on the **Proxies** tab.
5. Check the option **Automatic Proxy Configuration**.
6. In the **URL** field, type exactly: <http://bibliotheque.etsmtl.ca/proxy.pac> and click on the **OK** button.
7. Close and reopen your browser.

If using the Firefox browser on a Mac, follow the instructions in the Mozilla Firefox section.

iPad

1. Access the **Settings** app.
2. In the Wi-Fi settings, make sure you are connected to a network.
3. Click on the **blue i button** next to the network you are using (or the blue arrow on older iOS versions).
4. In the section **HTTP Proxy** at the bottom, select **Auto**.
5. In the **URL** field, type exactly: <http://bibliotheque.etsmtl.ca/proxy.pac>

Android devices

1. From the top of the screen, swipe down (twice) to access the device menu.
2. Select the network you are using from the list.
3. Click on **More settings** at the bottom.
4. In the list of available Wifi networks, press and hold on the name of the network that will be used with the proxy. A submenu will appear.
5. Click on **Modify network**, and then on **Advanced options**.
6. Under **Proxy settings**, click on the small arrow to select **Proxy Auto-Config**.
7. Under **PAC URL**, type exactly: <http://bibliotheque.etsmtl.ca/proxy.pac>
8. Click on **Save**.

Once this configuration is done, use your identifiers to access the library's online subscriptions.
